The safety and security of our students is our highest priority. Currently, the Coronavirus is receiving significant media coverage. There are NO reported cases of Coronavirus in our school district or in Pennsylvania. However, we are closely monitoring the spread of this virus in the United States.

We are providing information, so you are aware of this issue. Please be assured that Columbia Borough School District administrators will continue to monitor, prepare for, and respond to an health or safely use that may impact us. Our school nurses will continue to monitor students for symptoms of colds, flu, and any type of virus. They will follow our normal protocol of contacting you immediately if the videted any illness in your students.

As we work with the Center for Disease Control (CDC), we are reminding students and families to follow these steps to prevent any respiratory virus:

- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when sick. If your child has a fever, he/she should be kept home until fever free for 24 hours without medication.
- · Cough or sneeze into an elbow or use a tissue and place immediately in the trash.
- · Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
